PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED WHEN DOCUMENTS ARE EXECUTED IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1. The document must first be witnessed before a local notary public in the District of Columbia
2. The document must be certified under the seal of the District of Columbia, The seal is obtained from the District of Columbia Government. Notarial Section:
